



SA GEOGRAPHERS' FIELDWORK AWARDS YEARS 7-12 2023

The Fieldwork Awards challenge students in Years 7-12 in South Australia to investigate a geographical topic or issue of their choice



OBJECTIVES

Using a variety of fieldwork data collection, presentation and analysis techniques students will complete an inquiry-based fieldwork project.

Entries can be:

- completed individually or in collaboration with students of the same year level.
- presented as a written report or in a multi-modal format, such as <u>StoryMaps</u>.
- work completed in 2023 as part of SACE or International Baccalaureate Programmes

JUDGING

Entries will be judged by a panel of experts according to: originality of fieldwork techniques; creativity in conveying geographical information; and the strength of conclusions and recommendations.

A winner will be selected from each year level from Year 7-12.

Years 7-9 (max. 1000 words or 6 minute equivalent) Years 10-12 (max. 2500 words or 12 minute equivalent)
